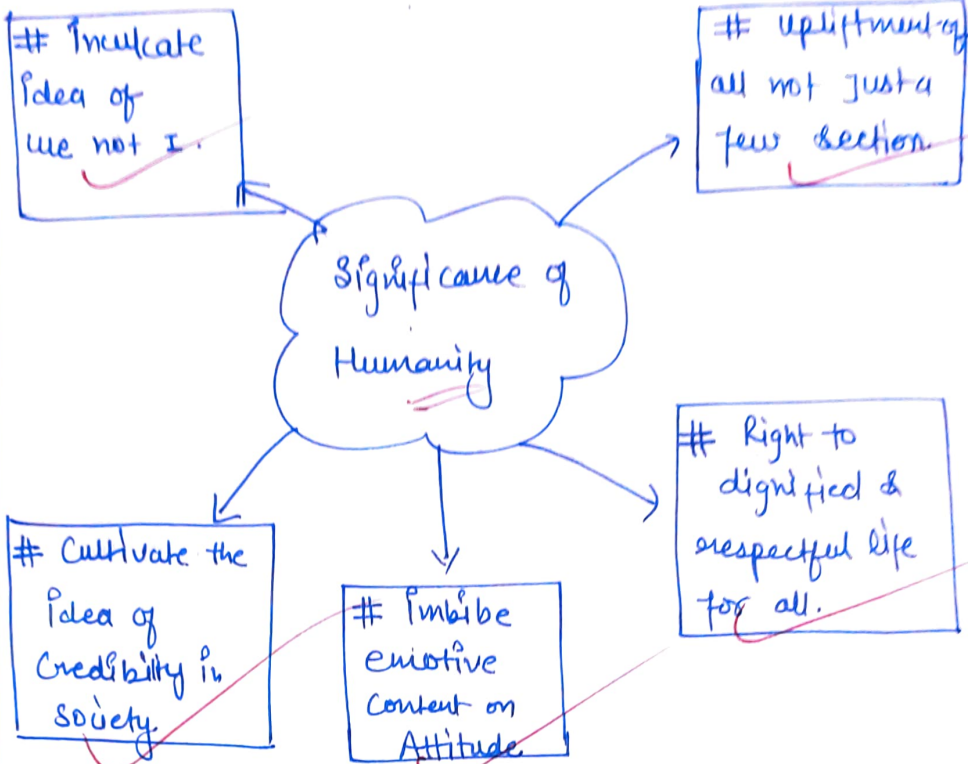

(1) It helps in identifying things which are good or bad for human being.

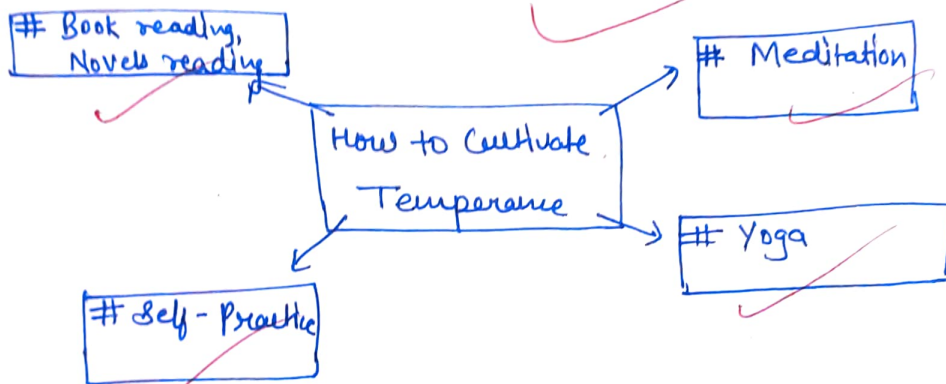
Ex A particular action is good or bad can be taken only when we cultivate temperance.

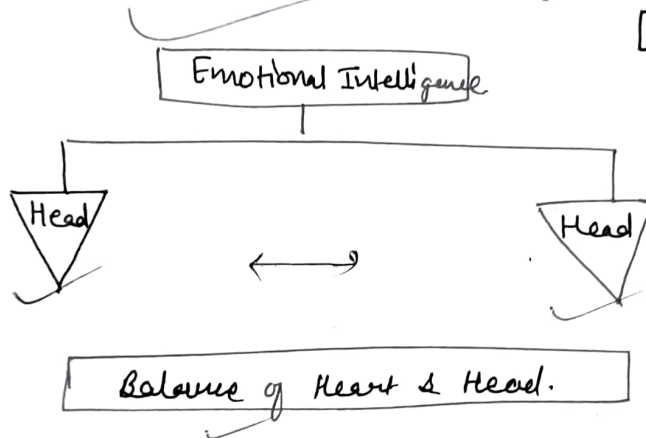

with good care for all stake holders.

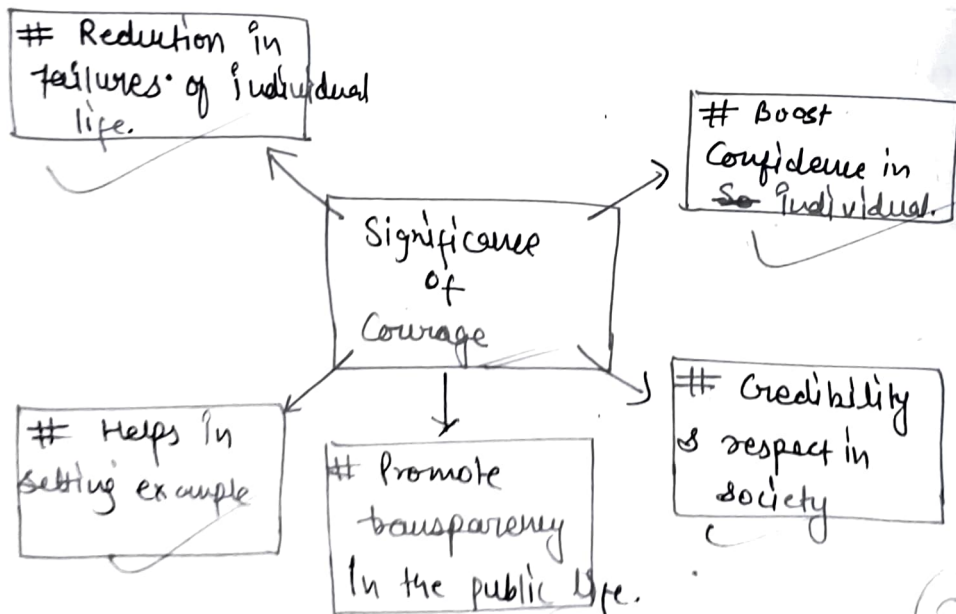

(2) Courage :- It is the triumph over fear, and ready to do difficult & infrequent tasks.

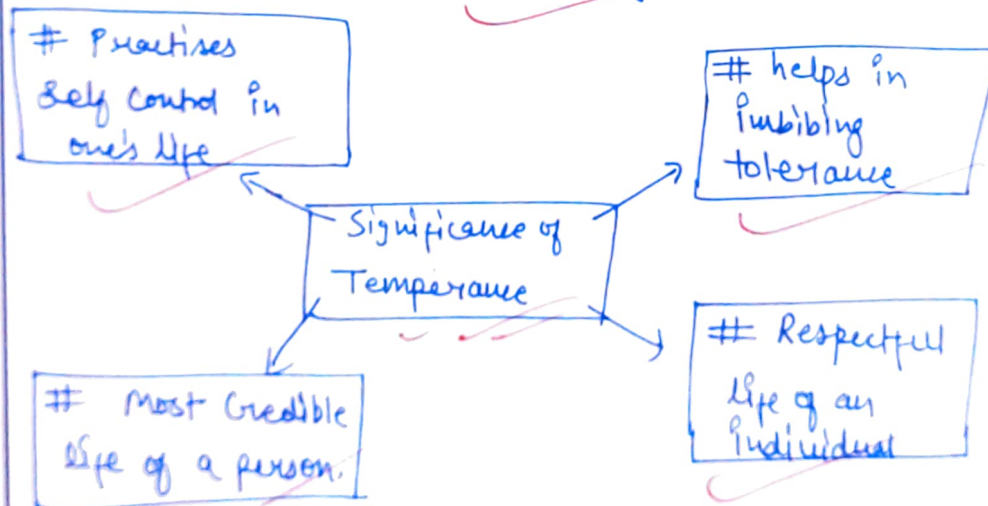
Ex. Alexander showed courage when his fellow army denied to cross river Beas to come in India.

Ex. Gandhi ji understood the Cause of Champaran peasants' problem and he started first civil disobedience for removing their misery.

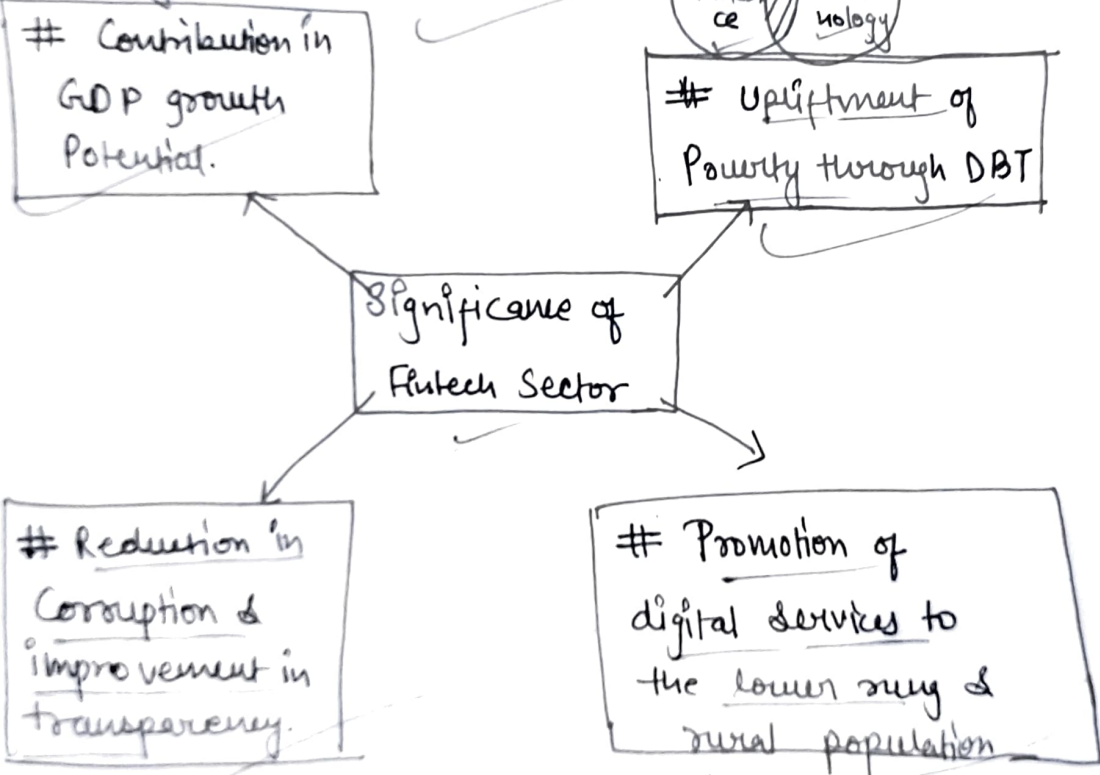
Selfless actions helps a person to remove

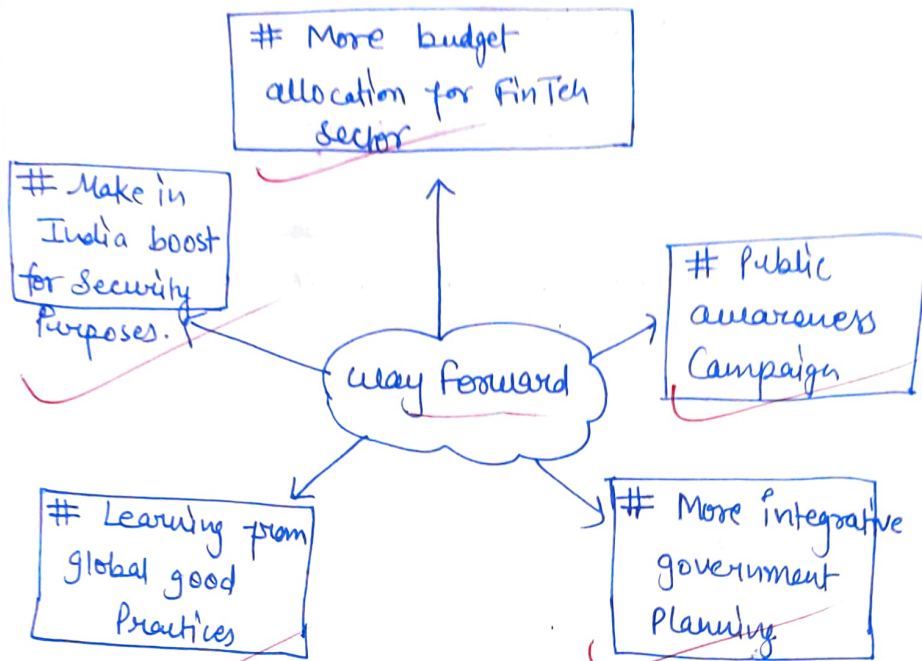
